2.FIGHTING CORRUPTION

In order to fight corruption, the NEFC Party will create institutions, agencies and passed requisite laws.

Parliament through the public accounts committee, which is chaired by the opposition holds the Executive accountable, which is the effective and reliable check. To defeat the corruption of need, NEFC Party will carry out a pay reform and continue with salary enhancements to remove injustices and address the compression ratio in salary scales. This will enable the salary of lower-level cadres to meet their basic needs. We are already progressively dealing with this, starting with teachers, soldiers and medical officers. We are going to defeat corruption of greed

in the national resources and accumulate wealth, live where we want, love who we want, say what we believe, develop our talents and pursue our dreams.

Freedom is the engine of progress that will drive Namibia forward. It inspires our people to be innovative and allows the entrepreneurial spirit to thrive. In an environment of maximum freedom, everyone is empowered to participate in a growing economy and live a dignified life.

People cannot be free without a piece of land, respectable standard of living, which requires access to education, healthcare and quality basic services. NEFC Party Government want to free people from the chains of poverty and the oppression of crime, giving meaning to real freedom.

Through ICT, NEFC Party will minimize human-tohuman contact in the delivery of services. This has already started in the issuance of passports and driving licenses, thereby eliminating bribery. This will be rolled out in the provision of other services and earn confidence in NEFC's delivery of services.

Furthermore, NEFC Party will also introduce timelines during certain services are delivered. For instance, when one applies for a land title, it should be clearly stated when the applicant will receive it. This will apply to issuance of all government licenses. The current state of affairs where one waits indefinitely for a government service creates opportunities for errant officials to ask for bribes.

For instance, the sub-county or the district council can address the problems of theft of drugs and tender's awards in their sub-county as well as tackling the problem of poor service delivery in education, water and roads.

18.THE DUAL (CUSTOMARY AND STATE) LAND OWNERSHIP SYSTEM AND WILL ENSURE THAT:

19.MINING, OIL AND GAS, ENERGY

The NEFC Party sees reforms in mining and energy as important ingredients for transforming Namibia's mining industry. While NEFC Party's economic plans point to a heavy reliance on current and projected income from extractive resources and mega-projects like energy. The NEFC Party is not banking its promised plans entirely on extractives, a smart strategy at a time when the global extractive industry is confronting various challenges.

The NEFC Party became increasingly critical of the ruling party's failure to channel mineral wealth into socio-economic development and the nation and accused the ruling party of acting in the interests of foreign mining multinationals and not ordinary Namibians. Ahead of and during the 2024 general elections, The NEFC Party will have a campaigned on an anti-foreign mining platform, focusing on the limited benefits and socioeconomic burdens imposed by foreign mining companies due to what they called corrupt contracts between the companies and the government. The party criticized foreign companies' poor contribution to the economy, tax evasion, and the abuse and killing of small-scale miners.

The NEFC Party also condemned the adverse social and environmental impacts of large-scale foreign mines. It became clear that NEFC is keen to

13.SMALL BUSINESS ENTERPRISES

Research conducted by NEFC Business Project from 2020-2022 revealed that Namibia's formal small business sector is much smaller than previously thought. It found there are only a few formal small and medium enterprises (SMEs) which are financial viable, firms employing less people, in Namibia. Though they comprise 80 % of all formal businesses, they employ only 20% of the formal workforce.

Namibia has an abundance of world-class large fishing and mining companies but, with so much of the population excluded from the national resources and wealth, their contribution to the country's social and economic wellbeing is limited. Achieving higher rates of economic and employment growth in Namibia requires a more collaborative relationship between large and small businesses leading to the creation of more small businesses, both formal and informal.

The NEFC Party will put policies that help create more small businesses at the forefront of our economic agenda for change. Financing more SME'S and Namibians to run capitalize on the widespread feeling that Namibia was gaining very little from its mineral resources, and the party turned mining and the fight against foreign mining companies into its main platform for political mobilization, as I have discussed elsewhere. NEFC's Party 2024 election manifesto featured mining-related campaign slogans such as "Namibians first", or 'Our natural resources for our development'. In its 2024 election manifesto, The NEFC Party promised that if it got into power the state would actively take part in minerals-related activities from exploration and extraction in joint ventures with either domestic or foreign private-sector partners.

The NEFC Party 2024 manifesto also promised state ownership of not less than 50 percent of all minerals-related ventures and the creation of a special minerals fund for use by future generations.

The NEFC Party manifesto acknowledges that Namibia's mineral resources must benefit both current and future generations and that therefore "we must use these resources carefully so that future generations can benefit" in the days ahead. To ensure that the country's minerals benefit present and future generations, The NEFC Party government will introduce the following measures.

The NEFC Party national government would implement a plan on Small Business Development: Firstly, introduce an overtly prosmall business policy approach. Growing the number and success rate of small businesses is the key to reducing unemployment. This starts with improving government and private sector advocacy of small business development.

The NEFC will:

- Introduce a start-up free investment policy incentive to attract direct investment by foreign entrepreneurs in the Namibian economy and partnership with local SME entrepreneurs. This will be priority within the first 180 days of entering office.
- Reinvigorate Initiative with the goal of injecting new energy and optimism into the business sector. Policy uncertainty and conflicting agendas have led to growing frustration within Business in Namibia. Soon after assuming office, the NEFC Party government will convene The Namibian

The party promised to establish a mechanism for joint ventures in mining between Namibian miners and foreigners. This move is aimed at enabling Namibians who lack the capital and technology to benefit from such joint ventures with companies that can provide capital and modern mining technology.
